



Toontown Rewritten Quality Assurance QA Tester Application

Thank you for showing interest in becoming part of the Toontown Rewritten Quality Assurance Team! Before you start filling out this application, there are a few things you should know:

1. **Toontown Rewritten is a volunteer effort.** No income or salary is provided as compensation for anyone's involvement.
 2. **Most QA Testers are not part of the full team.** QA Testers need to be able to test new features with fresh eyes. They don't necessarily need to know the backstory behind how said features were made. Therefore, QA Testers are not given full team access like others on our staff. However, Testers who demonstrate qualities that go above and beyond may be promoted to the full team later on.
 3. **Attention to detail is key.** QA Testers play all aspects of the game and are expected to give good feedback, write good tests for new functionality, find quality bug reports, and investigate bugs reported by the community. Basically, you're trying to break the game before it reaches production so major flaws can be addressed before public releases.
 4. **Experience is a major component of any QA team.** QA Testers need to have a very good knowledge of the game and be able to spot issues compared to how things function on production. Prior testing on the Toontown Online Test Server or real-life quality assurance or beta testing experience is a huge plus!
 5. **All pre-release content is confidential.** QA Testers will be testing new releases prior to public announcements and are expected to keep pre-release content confidential until it is announced and released publicly.

As a QA Tester for Toontown Rewritten, you will be working with the Programming, Audio, Art, Support, and Moderation teams to find issues in pre-release versions of our game on our dedicated QA Servers. You will be responsible for finding bugs, creating test cases for new features, testing fixes for bugs, and reproducing bugs reported by our community.

We are searching for QA Testers who have a passion to help Toontown improve, an open mind on new features to give feedback during the pre-release processes, and preferably have prior experience in





testing any game or app. We also are looking for those who have a disability (or are parents of children with a disability) who can help test accessibility features, though this is not required to apply. Necessary accommodations will be provided for disabled testers for meetings and other forms of communication.

Position Requirements

- Must be at least 16 years of age when playing on your own or be a parent of a child who has a disability and can help test accessibility features.
- Must have an account that is at least 6 months old and have at least a 50-Laff Toon. 100+ Laff Toons with all boss suits and at least 10 golfing and karting trophies are preferred.
- Must be recently active in-game or in the community for at least 2 consecutive months. This means showing activity for at least a couple days each week for a period of at least 2 months.
- All Toontown Rewritten accounts under your ownership must have no major infractions on record.
- For non-disabled players: While not required, having prior experience in QA testing professionally or via open or closed beta testing of software, or having been a Toontown Online Test Server player who was active during the Disney days of the game is a HUGE plus!
- Must not be under any non-compete agreements that prevent QA testing for others in the video game industry if currently working professionally in the industry.
- Must be the primary owner of the computer used for sharing confidential releases, and the system must have password, fingerprint or face authentication and not be able to be used with an auto-login shared account.
- Computers used must run Windows 10+, macOS 10.12+, or any currently supported 64-bit Linux distro release. Having a compatible Game Controller is preferred but not required.
