Render Artist Application

Thank you for showing interest in becoming part of the Toontown Team! Before you start filling out this application, there are a few things you should know:

- 1. **Toontown Rewritten is a volunteer effort.** No income or salary is provided as compensation for anyone's involvement.
- 2. A Render Artist's role is to create assets for digital graphics and print media. Your work will be used on our website, social media, and conventions and must be print ready.
- 3. Critiques are always given. You may be asked to make multiple fixes before it is accepted.
- 4. **Toontown's style is set in stone.** When creating illustrations, it is very important to keep the current art style in mind. We are working on a game based on an existing design that the original art team left behind.

ABOUT THE ROLE

The Brand Art role is broken into three groups based on your preferences and experiences. Some artists like sketching ideas out and others like finalizing work. Others just like the whole process of creating illustrations! These roles are Brand Artist, Sketch Artist, and Render Artist.

This application is for the **Render Artist** position. If you are interested in any other roles, please check them out <u>here</u>.

As a Render Artist for Toontown Rewritten, you will be finalizing sketches created by Sketch and Brand Artists that will be used to represent our game both digitally and physically. This may include graphics for our website, interactive crafts, and merchandise.

We are looking for Render Artists who are not only capable of creating works that are up to a professional standard, but a creative and hard-working mindset.





POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Must have a Toontown Rewritten account that is at least six months old.
- Understand artistic principles in regards to environmental design.
- Should have a strong understanding of perspective, and be able to create multiple angles of the same area or object.
- Ability to clearly express an idea through visual representation in a timely manner.
- Strong researching skills for building references based on various eras.
- Must be the primary owner of the computer used for sharing confidential files.
- Have sufficient time to dedicate for communication and discussion on top of the time used for creating artwork.

After we receive your email, we'll follow up within a few days and will file away your information until the position is open for recruitment.

REQUIRED CHALLENGE

The challenge is to create a finalized drawing (or rendered) of a sketch already provided. To the right is a sketch of a Legal Eagle. You can use the website as a reference for how to approach this. There is a PSD of the file along with a color guide for you to use within the PSD.

Extra Details:

- You must work in CMYK & set the file to 300 DPI. Work large!
- You must include the PSD of your illustration upon the submission of this application.
- Make sure to work with **only vector tools in Photoshop**.

The Legal Eagle file you will be referencing can be downloaded from this link.



Additionally, please provide other examples of your work with a link to your portfolio, YouTube, or any other host that you use for presenting your artwork online to viewers. If you don't use a website host, please attach your digital artwork to this email as .jpg or .png image files. You must include at least three pieces of your best work. Please provide at least **two** environmental pieces when providing your work.
