Video Editor Application

Thank you for showing interest in becoming part of the Toontown Team! Before you start filling out this application, there are a few things you should know:

- 1. **Toontown Rewritten is a volunteer effort.** No income or salary is provided as compensation for anyone's involvement.
- Video Editors work primarily with "in game" and occasionally "real world" scenarios. The
 videos that Video Editors mainly produce are gameplay videos. Occasionally, we use footage
 from our annual convention to produce advertisements.
- 3. **Critiques and feedback are always given**. You may be asked to make multiple fixes and revisions before your video is used.
- 4. Videos created are owned and uploaded by Toontown Rewritten. Videos created are to be used as Toontown Rewritten marketing materials, and cannot be uploaded to personal accounts without permission. These videos can be used, however, on personal portfolios and resumes.
- 5. **In-game activity is considered.** We are looking for Video Editors who actively play Toontown Rewritten. We are looking for applicants who have at least one month of consistent gameplay when we receive and review their application.

ABOUT THE ROLE

As a Video Editor for Toontown Rewritten, you'll be working closely with the team to create professional videos on a regular basis to be used as marketing materials for the game. These videos can consist of advertisements, animated shorts, upcoming content announcements, real world event footage, and other projects for the entertainment of our players.

We are looking for a Video Editor with a professional level of skill who can create unique, cinematic, and entertaining shorts using more than typical gameplay recordings.





POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 16 years of age.
- Must have a Toontown Rewritten account that is at least six months old.
- Must be recently active in-game or in the community for at least one month. This means showing activity for at least a couple days each week for a period of at least one month.
- Knowledge of professional cinematic techniques on at least an intermediate level.
- Ability to produce videos that meet or exceed the quality of those currently seen on the Toontown Rewritten <u>YouTube Channel</u>.
- Extensive skills in video editing programs such as Adobe After Effects or Adobe Premiere
- Must be the primary owner of the computer used for sharing confidential files.

After we receive your email, we'll follow up within a few days and will file away your information until the position is open for recruitment.

REQUIRED CHALLENGE

With the style, music, and content of your choice, create a 30 to 90 second advertisement or short for Toontown Rewritten. You can use videos on our own YouTube Channel such as our <u>"Seltzer and Slapstick"</u>, <u>"Take Back The Town"</u>, and <u>Doing Things Differently advertisements</u> for inspiration. After you are finished, upload this video to a hosting website of your choice and provide a link to it in your application.

Extra Details:

- The video created should be no longer than 90 seconds, and should demonstrate clear professional capability.
- If you choose to use music, avoid using copyrighted music in this video without explicit
 permission from the owner. You may use any track from Toontown Rewritten's soundtrack or
 royalty-free tracks.
- Your video will not be judged on the writing capability, only on the creativity and capability of video editing techniques.
